# We are honoring our partnership with NYCBS and Dr. Jeffrey Vacirca



Jeffrey Vacirca, MD, FACP, attended Suffolk County Community College as part of his educational journey to become a renowned cancer physician and visionary leader with extensive experience and commitment to community oncology. He assumed the role of CEO and Chairman of the Board of New York Cancer & Blood Specialists (NYCBS) in 2008 and has led the practice through an unparalleled period of transformation. NYCBS

now sees nearly a million patients a year through a network of more than 30 oncology locations and 35 hospital affiliations.

Dr. Vacirca is the past president of the Community Oncology Alliance (COA) and continues to be a member of their executive committee. He is a co-founder and board member of OneOncology and serves on the board of directors of Assertio Therapeutics, Inc. and the American Red Cross of Greater New York. Additionally, Dr. Vacirca serves as a Scientific Advisory Board Member for Caris Life Sciences and is president and co-founder of the National Translational Research Group.

Dr. Vacirca is the medical director for Oncology Network Development at Mt. Sinai Health Network and Long Island Association for Aids Care (LIAAC). He serves on the board of directors for PatientPoint and Annexus Health. Previously, Dr. Vacirca served on the board of Spectrum Pharmaceuticals and as the Medical Director for the International Oncology Network, part of AmerisourceBergen, where he was part of their contracting advisory board for almost 15 years. In 2014, Dr. Vacirca founded the New York Cancer Foundation, which provides financial assistance to patients undergoing treatment for cancer. He serves as Chairman of the Board. He also formed the Conquering Cancer PAC, which advocates for cancer patients and strives to ensure access and availability for all patients no matter where they live. Dr. Vacirca has received honors such as Humanitarian of the Year by the American Red Cross and its Corporate Leadership Award on behalf of NYCBS. He was awarded the Red Door Award for Leadership and Cancer Advocacy by the Red Door Community and received the Founder's Medalist by The Brooklyn Hospital Center. Dr. Vacirca also received the Theodore Roosevelt Award for outstanding dedication to patient care.



With the vision of a world free of cancer and blood disorders, New York Cancer & Blood Specialists searches for cures by offering cutting-edge clinical trials and personalized, state-of-the-art treatments that save and prolong lives. In partnership with the college, NYCBS has established a fellowship program that supports up to ten student interns annually.

Raynor, Course Designer WESTHAMPTON COUNTRY CLUB HISTORY Incorporated in 1890 with 28 original members, largely residents of the Beach Lane area of the village. Facilities included a baseball field, tennis courts, a trapshooting range and a boat dock on Moniebogue Bay. Sailing was an important activity, continuing until 1939 when the Westhampton Yacht Squadron split off as a separate entity. The Club flag is still in the form of a yacht club burgee.

The popularity of golf grew, and in 1914 land leased west of Potunk Lane is where the present course, designed and constructed by Seth J. Raynor, opened for play in 1916. Raynor's mentorship into designing courses started when he was hired to survey and later supervise the construction of the National Golf Links of America (NGLA) designed by Charles Blair Macdonald. NGLA is a fusion of Macdonald's favorite features from the first courses in the British Isles – termed "ideal holes." After many golf course collaborations adopting ideal holes, Macdonald urged Raynor to set out on his own. His first solo design, considered his best, which includes ideal holes, was Westhampton Country Club.

Other golf clubs attributed to Raynor include: Camargo, Chicago, Creek,

Fishers Island, Greenbrier, Monterey Peninsula, Shinnecock Hills, Southampton, Waialae, Yale, and Yeamans Hall. WESTHAMPTON RULES & REGULATIONS

Proper attire is required while at Westhampton Country Club, particularly while on the golf course and practice range. All hats must be worn with the bill always facing forward and gentlemen are required to remove their hats when indoors. Denim, tank tops, racerback tops, casual t-shirts, swimwear, cargo shorts, cargo pants, short skirts/shorts, and other athletic clothing are not permissible on the Golf Course, Range, and in the Clubhouse, and shall not be considered proper attire at any time. Collarless short-sleeved shirts will not be permitted on the golf course. Men's shorts must be Bermuda (knee length) style. Female golfers shall wear reserved length skirts to be no shorter than mid-thigh, Bermuda-length shorts, or slacks. Their shirts may be sleeveless with a collar, or collarless with sleeves. Use of cellular devices are not permitted in the Clubhouse - parking lots only.
